Qualifications:

Responsibilities:

- 1. Enforce Erskine Green Training Institute (EGTI) policies during overnight and morning hours.
- 2. Provide general assistance with morning activities when students are preparing for the day (e.g. time management, appropriate dress, breakfast, etc.).
- 3. Make arrangements in the event of an absence.
- 4. Communicate and collaborate with EGTI full-time staff, nurse, community living support, and other overnight support.
- 5. Communicate with EGTI staff to determine immediate coverage and need of support should a student emergency occur or immediate need transpire.
- 6. Communicate with hotel staff.
