


At a Glance Duke Energy Indiana









We energize our communities and enhance the quality of life for the people who live here.

- We are the largest electric utility in Indiana with operations headquartered in Plainfield, Ind., providing electric service in a 23,000-square-mile service area.
- We serve approximately 820,000 Indiana customers and provide power to a number of other wholesale customers.

State-Specific Operational Facts

- More than 36,200 miles of transmission and distribution lines
- Total capacity of 6,800 megawatts at 14 power generation sites composed of 64 percent coal-fired, 25 percent natural gas-fired, 8 percent syngas-fired, 2 percent oil-fired and less than 1 percent hydro-powered
- 89 percent of energy generation from coal, burned 11.9 million tons of coal in 2016

Indiana Taxpayer - Hoosier State Employer

Duke Energy is a major Indiana taxpayer and employer of Hoosiers.

- Paid \$65 million in property, use and utility receipt taxes in 2016
- Collected and sent \$106 million to the state in sales tax receipts
- Approximately 2,500 employees
- Approximately \$295 million paid in payroll

Customer Service
