About

Erskine Green Training Institute's (EGTI) programming is designed for individuals whose academic, social, communication, and adaptive skills are affected due to a disability. Students must be out of high school and 18 years of age or older. EGTI is a certificate program, however, some students may earn an industry recognized certification depending upon the training program selected.

Location

EGTI has two locations: Muncie and Indianapolis. While some training programs are offered at both locations, some are offered only at one. Reference the EGTI website for details. EGTI Muncie offers a residential option for students to live on site at the Courtyard Muncie for the duration of their training program. This is not something currently offered at EGTI Indianapolis.

Student Life

For students attending a training program at EGTI Muncie, they have the opportunity to live on site to grow their independence in other ways. Although students who live nearby have the option to commute, over 97% of the students who attend EGTI Muncie live on site where support of EGTI staff is available during evening, weekend, and overnight hours. With the support of staff, students learn to fill their evenings and weekends with activities: dinner with other students, trips to the mall, activities on Ball State University's campus, movies, game nights, etc.
