Erskine Green Training Institute's (EGTI) programming is designed for individuals whose academic, social, communication, and adaptive skills are affected due to a disability. Students must be out of high school and 18 years of age or older. EGTI students earn a certification in their area of training. Depending on the training program, some students may earn an industry-recognized certification.

Locations

EGTI offers training in Muncie and Indianapolis. Please refer to EGTI's website for details on training programs offered at each location.

EGTI Muncie offers a residential option for students to live on-site at the Courtyard Muncie throughout their training program. EGTI Indy is a commuter program.

Students attending a training program at EGTI Muncie have the opportunity to live on-site. Although students who live nearby have the option to commute, over 97% of the students who attend EGTI Muncie live on-site where EGTI staff is available during the evening and weekend to support students in gaining social skills and increased independence. Career Sampling Sessions
